St Thomas's Church is pleased to be able to offer young musicians an opportunity to build on the church's fine choral tradition by offering choral and organ scholarships.

Our choir regularly sings services around Norfolk and has sung in recent times in the Lake District, and Norwich Cathedral.

The church is situated on the Earlham Road and in close proximity to the UEA

Choral Scholars rehearse on Friday evenings from 7.30-9pm and sing in two services on a Sunday at 10.30am and 6.30pm. Each scholar receives £500 per year.

The Organ Scholars assist the Director of Music in playing for and directing our choir and will have responsibility of our extensive music library. They will be expected to help lead and develop the choir too.

St Thomas church dates back to 1888 and was extensively damaged during the World War II. It was built to cater for the large expansion of the Heigham area.

We work collaboratively with our Ecumenical links locally and have a link with a church in Haltern, Germany.

We boast an excellent organ rebuilt by Bower and Company in 1979 and extensive work has been completed also in 2006. It has gained further international recognition during the recent release of a CD on the Priory Label 'Exhilarations and Reflections'
